Rules & Regulations

1. Riders may enter up to two (2) consecutive divisions plus any number of special classes (i.e. Ride and Run, Team classes, or Gambler's Choice that correspond to the divisions entered).
2. ❖ **Team of Three Hunters** – Entries will be taken at the gate prior to the class. The course will be posted prior to the class with an explanation of how jumps will be jumped. Some jumps will be jumped single file; some will be jumped in pairs, and one jump will be taken by all three riders together.
3. ❖ **Ride and Run** – Entries will be taken at the gate prior to the class; only the Rider needs to enter. A runner on foot completes the course ahead of a rider on horseback who cannot pass the runner. Team with the fastest combined time will be winners.
4. **Table A** – Classes will have Immediate Jump Off (if rider is clear, they will immediately ride the Jump Off course following the starter's whistle).
5. **Power and Speed** – First half of the course is the "power" portion of the class, if it is jumped clear, then the rider will continue with the second half of the course which will be timed, the "speed" portion. If there are any faults in the power portion of the course, the jump judge will signal the rider to exit the ring.
6. **Gamblers Choice** – The fastest time over a course of the rider's choice which must include all fences. Knock downs and refusals will add 5 seconds to your time. There will be a Jeopardy Jump at the end which will be your choice if you want to jump it or not. If you make it over the Jeopardy Jump, 10 seconds will be taken off your time; if you don't make it 10 seconds will be added to your time.
7. ❖ **Team Relay** – Entries will be taken at the gate prior to the class. There will be 2 riders per team, and the fastest team wins. The 1st rider will jump the first half of course then tag second rider for second half of course. 5 seconds will be added to time for each knock down or refusal.
8. ❖ **Three Bar Challenge** – Entries will be taken at the gate prior to the class. One warm up fence will be allowed before going down a line of 3 vertical jumps. After each rider has had a turn, each rider who has gone clear will continue to next round. Fences will be raised 2" each round. The last rider to go clear will be the winner.
9. **Lead Line** – horse must have a halter and lead shank and riders must be 6 years and under. Riders **MUST wear a Helmet**. Riders may not enter in other classes. AEF Number is not required.
10. **Junior riders** will be under 18 years as of January 1st of the current year; **Senior riders** will be 18 years and over as of January 1st of the current year.
11. **EC/AEF Membership** – every rider must provide proof of either a provincial or national sport license or membership.
12. This show is run similar to the rules of the C.E.F. or E.C. It shall be the responsibility of each exhibitor to have full knowledge of the classes in which he/she is showing. Anyone not abiding by the rules will be disqualified. The decision of the Judge, Steward, and Show Committee is final.
13. **Stallions** are not to be handled by anyone under the age of 18 years.
14. Classes may be cancelled, combined, or further divided at the discretion of the Show Committee. The Show Committee may cancel the show without notice.
15. We would appreciate receiving entries 1 week prior to the show date. **Post entries** will be accepted the day of the show. Entry fees are payable to the **Extreme Stables**. Any entries unsigned will be refused entry into the ring.
16. A Veterinarian or Doctor's certificate is mandatory for any refund of entry fees less a handling fee.
17. Three (3) minute gate only on request. All scratched horses and classes to be reported to the Gateman.
18. Inhumane treatment will not be tolerated and unruly horses may be excused from the ring.
19. The Show Committee Members, Directors, or affiliates of the Show will NOT be held responsible or liable in any manner for any or all accident(s) or injury(s) to any person(s) of any extent including participant(s) of the show or spectator(s); damage or theft of any person(s) material or equipment or any other possessions owned, rented, or loaned to any person(s) who are on the premises where the Show is located for the duration of the Show.
20. The Show Committee will endeavour to prevent the loss of, or damage to, any exhibitor but will not be held responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
21. Protests must be made to the Show Committee within 48 hours of the class and must be in writing and accompanied by \$250.00 cash.
22. All patterns will be posted at least one (1) hour prior to the class.
23. NSF Cheques will be charged a \$30.00 fee.

In return for use, today and all future dates, of the property and services of the Stable and its representative, the Horse Owner/Rider, their heirs and legal representatives hereby agree to the following:

1. It is the responsibility of the Horse Owner/Rider or their Guardian to carry complete insurance of their horse, personal property, and self.
2. Horse Owner/Rider agrees to assume **ANY AND ALL RISKS INVOLVED IN OR ARISING FOR RIDERS USE OF OR PRESENCE UPON STABLE'S PROPERTY OR FACILITIES** including but not limited to the risk of death, bodily injury, property damage, falls and kicks, bites, collisions with vehicles, horses and stationary objects, fire or explosions, the availability of emergency medical care, or the negligence or deliberate acts of another person.
3. Horse Owners/Rider agree to hold Stable and all of their successors, assigns, subsidiaries, franchises, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, and agents completely harmless and not liable and releases them from all liability whatsoever and **AGREES NOT TO SUE** them on account of or in connection with any claims, causes of actions, injuries, damages, costs or expenses arising out of Horse Owner / Rider use or presence upon property and facilities owned or leased by Stables, including without limitation, those based on death, bodily injury, property damage, including consequential damages, except if the damages are caused by the direct, wilful and wanton negligence of the Stable.
4. Horse Owner/Rider agrees to hold Stable and all of their successors, assigns, subsidiaries, franchises, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, and agents completely harmless and not liable and release them from all liability whatsoever and **AGREES NOT TO SUE** them on account of or in connection with any claims, cause of action, injuries, damages, cost or expense arising out of Horse Owner/ Rider decision to participate in shows, activities, events, clinics, etc. occurring at Stable or at locations away for Stables, including without limitation, those based on death, bodily injury, property damage, including consequential damages, except if the damages are caused by the direct, wilful and wanton negligence of the Stables.
5. Horse Owner/ Rider agrees to waive the protection afforded by any statute or law in any jurisdiction whose purpose, substance, and/or effect is to provide that a general release shall not extend to claims, material or otherwise, which the person giving the release shall not or suspect to exist at the time of executing the release.
6. Horse Owner/ Rider agrees to indemnify and defend Stable against and hold harmless from any and all claims, causes of action, damages, judgement, costs or expenses, including attorney's fees which in any way arise from Horse Owner/ Rider use of or presence upon property owned or leased by Stable
7. Horse Owner/ Rider agree to abide by all of the Stables Rules and conditions of use.
8. Horse Owner/ Rider agrees to be totally responsible for any visitor or guests on the property or facilities owned or leased by the Stable at Horse Owner/ Rider invitation and agrees to hold Stable harmless for any injury or damages to Horse

Owner/Rider visitor or their personal property.

9. Horse Owner/Rider agrees to hold Stable or any of the Stables' agents totally harmless when hauling the Horse Owner/Rider horse for the purpose of horse showing, training, or moving the horse.

10, this contract is non-assignable and non-transferable and is made and entered into in the Province of Alberta, and shall be enforced and interpreted under the laws of this Province. When Horse Owner/Rider is a minor, the Parents/Guardians sign this contract; it will then be binding on all parties, subject to the above terms and conditions.

The undersigned hereby agree to comply strictly with the rules and regulations of the Stable and hereby acknowledge receipt of a copy of this release and indemnity agreement.
